



CAMPSITE RULES AND POLICIES

Entering the campsite implies acceptance of the rates in force and full compliance with these Regulations which are understood to be accepted by each individual user in all its parts. The Regulations may be supplemented separately by additional regulations that the Management deems appropriate to issue for the better functioning of the structure. It also entails the authorization to shoot video and photographs as part of the collective activities of the campsite. The staff is required to enforce the Regulations and to report to the Management who does not comply with them. The defaulters will be immediately removed from the camping.

A) GUEST REGISTRATION.

Upon arrival, all campers / users are required to hand over an identity document for each person in the family unit for legal registrations and to carry out the procedures relating to the destination of the pitch or housing unit.

The balance of the payment must be made upon arrival or according to the contractually established methods. In case of early departure or interruption of the booked stay, the customer will not be entitled to any refund; however, without prejudice to the right of the Management to reoccupy the housing unit or the pitch vacated in advance.

B) VISITORS.

Guests' visitors, if authorized by the Management and upon delivery of a document, can only enter on foot with the obligation to leave the campsite no later than 24.00 on the same day. After one hour of stay they are required to pay the daily rate. Entry to strangers is strictly forbidden, people caught inside the campsite not authorized by the Management will be reported to the competent authorities.

C) RULES OF CONDUCT.

Noises = Behaviour, activities and games that disturb other guests must be avoided at any time. Loud televisions and radios are strictly prohibited. From 13.30 to 15.00 and from 24.00 to 07.00 it is mandatory to respect the silence. During these hours the circulation of all motor vehicles is forbidden, as is the assembly and disassembly of tents and any other noise. **Vehicles** = The circulation of vehicles is allowed from 07.00 to 13.30 and from 15.00 to 24.00 respecting the speed of 10 km/h, the signs inside the campsite, as well as any other rules of prudent conduct. Those who have to leave or re-enter during the silence hours are requested to notify the Management by 19.30. The cars of the users must be parked only in the numbered space reserved for them by the Management. It is strictly forbidden to transit and park cars on the pitches. It is strictly forbidden to wash cars and motorcycles inside the campsite. **Waste disposal** = Paper, glass, plastic and compostable or unsorted waste must be deposited in the special containers located in different areas of the campsite. The toilet tanks must be emptied into the special chemical toilets and it is mandatory to use disintegrating products and special toilet paper. **Utilities** = Campers are required to use the services and the utilities of mobile homes and pitches avoiding wasting water, gas and electricity; in absence of the users it is strictly forbidden to leave on lights, air conditioners, fans and any other household appliance except the fridge. It is strictly forbidden to wash caravans, verandas, cars and motorcycles inside the campsite. Linen and dishes must be washed only in the special sinks in the toilet blocks. **Beach** = Access to the beach is allowed from 08.00 to 20.00. It is not allowed to bring tables and chairs to the private beach, nor to organize lunches and dinners there. On the private beach it is allowed only the use of the equipment (umbrellas, sunbeds, etc.) made available by the campsite. The maximum limit is 4 sunbeds under each umbrella.

Users are required to lock the gates that lead from the campsite to the bike path / beach. We also recall the resolution of the City Council n ° 97 of 28.05.02 art.2 lett. G, according to which it is forbidden to leave beach equipment (eg: umbrellas / sunbeds / deck chairs etc ...) on the free beach after sunset.

Prohibitions = It is strictly forbidden to damage the equipment and structures of the campsite, trees, plants and flowers, light fires in the open, dig pits, pour boiling, salty or waste liquids on the ground, install sheets to cover the verandas and gazebos. Any fences, boundaries, roof structures and bulky wooden platforms on the assigned pitch are also prohibited. It is forbidden to occupy and spread sheets in the walkways and in the common areas. It is absolutely forbidden to access the private areas of the structure such as warehouses, closets, workshops and in all places where prohibition signs are affixed.

D) MINORS.

Minors are admitted only if accompanied by parents or adult relatives. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied to the toilets, showers, games and the beach by an adult. For minors, the use of all the equipment and participation in the various activities inside the campsite and on the beach is allowed only under the strict supervision of their parents, who also undertake to ensure that they comply with the rules of conduct referred to in these Regulations.

E) ANIMALS.

The presence of animals must be reported at the time of booking. The entry of animals must be authorized by the Management. Dogs are allowed only if they are small and medium-sized.

Animals must be accompanied by vaccination documents, washed and periodically treated with anti-parasites. Breeds of dogs and animals deemed dangerous or reported as such by the competent authorities may be, at the discretion of the Management, removed from the campsite. It is the duty of the owners to ensure maximum compliance with hygiene and health standards during the animal's stay on the campsite. Inside the mobile homes, avoid letting them climb onto beds and sofas. Dogs must ALWAYS be kept on a leash by an adult. Owners are obliged to ALWAYS be equipped with the appropriate bags and to collect the physiological needs of their animals, possibly accompanying them on the access road outside the facility. The owners have the obligation to ALWAYS make sure that their animals do not disturb the other guests of the campsite; the owner will be solely responsible for any damage caused to third parties and to the structures. It is not allowed to leave animals alone in the squares and in the mobile homes. It is forbidden to bring animals inside the Minimarket. The Municipality of Pesaro prohibits the access of animals to the beach.

F) LIABILITY EXEMPTION.

Each camper is required to keep the objects owned by him.

The Management is not responsible for any theft and/or loss of any kind and entity that may occur inside the campsite, on the beach and in the boat storage. The Management is also not liable for any damage caused to cars, mopeds, campers, caravans, tents, boats and, in general, to all movable property owned by campers.

The Management is not responsible for fires caused by campers, who are however responsible for any damage caused to the structures and equipment of the campsite and to third parties. The campsite management declines all responsibility for damage to persons and/or property deriving from the use of the equipment made available to campers (only by way of non-limiting example: beach volleyball-beach tennis courts, games for children); such use is at the risk of campers; as well as declines all responsibility for damage to people and/or property caused by participation in the various activities within the campsite and on the beach. The Management also declines any responsibility for damage to things and people as a result of unforeseeable circumstances and/or force majeure (only by way of non-limiting example: hail, wind, rain, tornadoes, negligent and/or malicious events of third parties, etc.), or for any fact not attributable to the management and staff of the campsite.
