



CAMPSITE RULES AND POLICIES

On arrival, all campsite Guests, Tenants of bungalows as well as of pitches must show an identity card for each person of the family unit at the check-in time, according to the Italian law, and undergo all the formalities required to receive the pitch or the accommodation according to his/her booking. All the Guests of and Visitors to the campsite must agree and acknowledge that they should abide by and fully respect the Price list in force as well as the regulations herein outlined, that must be accepted by each single camping guest in all its parts. The Campground Management is entitled to add further rules to the present policy aiming to improve the general running of the campsite itself. It is also authorised to shot videos and take pictures during collective activities. Campsite operators and employees are supposed and authorized to supervise that each single Guest respects the policies herein outlined. Rule-breakers will be brought to the Campground Management's attention and will be immediately required to leave the campsite. Payment of the balance is due on arrival. In case of early departure, interruption of the booked stay, the customer must pay for the entire reserved period. The Campground Management reserves the right to re-occupy the pitch or the bungalow left in advance. Visitors will be admitted only under authorisation and by showing an identity card; they can enter the campsite only by foot and must leave the campsite within 00:00 a.m. If visitors stay longer than 1 hour, they shall pay the daily entrance fee, according to the Price List in force. It is strictly forbidden the entrance to external visitors, not regularly checked-in. Those who will be detected within the campsite property without regular admission given by the Campground Management, will be immediately denounced to the authorities concerned. All the campsite users are firmly required and recommended to avoid any act, behaviour and game, at any hour, causing nuisance to neighbours or to the other guests. It is strictly forbidden to keep TVs and radios at a high volume, for this reason parents must look after their children. Silence hours should be observed from 01:30 p.m. to 03:00 p.m. and from 12:00 a.m. (midnight) to 07:00 a.m. During this time it is forbidden using motor vehicles, pitching or unpitching tents, or/and any other activity that may cause noise or nuisances to other guests. Driving is allowed from 7:00 a.m. to 01:30 p.m. and from 03:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. (midnight) respecting speed limit (10 km/h) and traffic signs regulating the transit of motor vehicles inside the campground. Those who need to leave or re-enter during silence hours are required to let the reception desk know within 07:30 p.m. Guests' cars must be parked in their numbered parking spots reserved by the reception office. It is strictly forbidden to drive and park one's car onto the camping pitches. The Campground Management discharge all and any responsibility for thefts, loss or damage occurring within the campsite, on the beach, within the boat garaging; the Management also discharge all and any responsibility for any damage caused to cars, campers, caravans, tents, boats etc. and each guest is supposed and expected to take care of his/her own objects and property. It is strictly forbidden to damage campsite trees, plants, flowers and equipments; either it is not permitted to light open fires, dig holes around the pitches, pour boiling, salted or waste liquids on the ground, cover verandas and gazebos with ground cloths. It is also strictly not permitted to put up fences, sheltering or any other kind of covering structure round your pitch. The Campground Management discharge any responsibility for fires caused by guests who are in any case responsible for any damage to Camping facilities and equipments and to third parties. The Campground Management disclaims any responsibility for damage caused to any person or property due to neglect or misuse of equipments and facilities offered by the campsite to its guests (for example beach volley and beach tennis courts, games in the playground area, fitness area); the campsite Residents will be charged with all risks or consequences involved in or related to the use of the above-mentioned. Minors are permitted to use facilities and to take part to the different activities within the campsite and on the beach, only under their parents' strict control as strongly herein recommended. The Campground Management is exempted and held harmless from any and all liability, and any damage or injury to any person or property arising from weather conditions (including, but not limited to rain, wind, hail, tornados etc. unpremeditated and/or intentional events by third parties.) or resulting from any other cause and reasons happening whatsoever, beyond campsite management's control.

Minors under 18 will not be admitted to the campsite unless accompanied by their parents or adult relatives. Children must be accompanied to bathrooms, amenities, facilities, the playground on the beach by adults taking care of them. Small-size dogs are allowed according to Camping Dog Rules and Policies (See “Pets are our friends”) Paper, glass and plastic waste must be thrown away into their appropriate rubbish containers, in the recycling centers found in different areas of the Campingsite.

Waste-holding tanks of cassette toilets must be emptied in their appropriate chemical toilets and toilet fluid additives must be used together with toilet paper. Linen and dishes must solely be washed into the basins provided in the bathroom areas. Ironing is only allowed inside the ironing room. Camping Norina Residents are required to use water, gas and power without wasting in bathroom areas, in bungalows and camping pitches. It is strictly forbidden to wash cars and motorbikes inside the campsite.

ANIMALS

You must inform the Reception Desk about bringing your pets at time of booking. Pets admittance must be authorized by the Management. Dangerous dog breeds or dogs of certain breeds classified as such by the competent authority can be banned from the camping area at the Management’s discretion. All dogs (and other pets) must be inoculated according the relevant laws in force. Pets must be kept on a lead at all times and under their owners’ strict control who must properly dispose of their animals’ excrements. Pet owners are to be held liable for any damage, injury and nuisances caused by their pets to other guests and to the Campground facilities. It is forbidden to leave your animals alone in camping pitches and bungalows. Pesaro municipality does not allow pets at the beach.

BUNGALOWS

The number of the bungalow and its own parking spot are assigned by the Reception office who reserves the right to shift the bungalow previously booked and assigned to meet possible unexpected organizing needs of Camping Norina itself. Camping guests can occupy the bungalow assigned from 04:30 p.m. on the check-in day. No deposit refund will be granted on cancellation of confirmed stays. There is no refund or discount on the price in case of late arrival or early departure. No-shows within 11:00 p.m. on the check-in day without delay notice will be considered as a booking cancellation. Every guest agrees to take care of and is responsible for his/her bungalow assigned and is not allowed to decide on his/her own to move furniture inside the bungalow without prior permission. If any damage is caused to the property and equipment, the User will be required a refund for costs incurred to repair or replace damaged items.

The final cleaning is included in the price only if the bungalow will be left decently in order.

Otherwise the Direction of the Camping will reserve the right to charge the final cleaning according to the type of bungalow. In this regard the bungalow will be checked up at the end of stay.

On departure day, guests must leave the accommodation fully equipped within 9.30 a.m. Duration of stay is counted according to the number of the consecutive nights spent in the Campsite. Check-out time is within 9:30 a.m. on departure day, after that term, another night's rate will be charged.

CAMPING PITCHES

The number of the camping pitch and its own parking spot are assigned by the Reception desk who reserves the right to shift the camping pitch previously booked and assigned to meet possible unexpected organizing needs of Camping Norina itself. Camping guests must keep within camping pitch limits according to the directions of the Campground Management. Those who will trespass the limits of their assigned pitch, will be charged with two camping pitch rates. Camping guests can occupy the pitch assigned from 04:30 p.m. on the check-in day. No deposit refund will be granted on cancellation of confirmed stays. There is no refund or discount on the price in case of late arrival or early departure. No-shows within 11:00 p.m. on the check-in day without delay notice will be considered as a booking cancellation. Duration of stay is counted according to the number of the consecutive nights spent in the Campsite. Check-out time is within 12:00 a.m. on departure day, after that term, another night's rate will be charged. In the assigned pitch all Camping residents may connect to the water net, water drain and to power only by using the electric hook-up point shown by the camping staff. Campers are allowed to use only one electric socket and in case of prolonged absence and for safety reasons, they must disconnect their cables from the electric hook-up unit. Camping guests are invited to be very careful when connecting their sink to the drain (siphoned drain) in their own camping pitch in order to prevent unpleasant odours arising in their own field and in the neighbouring ones. It is strictly prohibited to modify the water drain system. Camping pitches must be left clean and clear of all property, refuse and litter. Check-out time is within 12:00 a.m. on departure day, after that term, another night's rate will be charged.
